Rating of methods and course performance




Figure 1: Average rating of overall impression of the course, individual benefit, course performance and methods (N = 8) (6=applies completely, 1=doesn't apply at all)




Figure 2: Average rating of the input of the participants and the atmosphere (N = 8) (6=applies completely, 1=doesn't apply at all)




Figure 3: Average rating of organization (6=applies completely, 1=doesn't apply at all)




Figure 4: Reasons for taking part in the course "Scientific Writing". Students (N = 8) should select all reasons that applied
